Born in the ancient city of Polonnaruwa, Sri Lanka, Rathnayake studied at the University of Visual and Performing Arts in Colombo. In this sequel to his 2018 exhibition titled 'Meaning of Simulation', the artist continues his investigation of the subjects of globalization, the climate crisis and digital culture.

JC Rathnayake makes paintings that give the appearance of calm and meditation with the depth of texture and colour. His process of creating works involves a multidisciplinary practice with his base that lies in printmaking. The artist breaks boundaries with his play on acrylic, collage and burning his medium to command an aesthetic that is an extraordinary visual representation of pattern, repetition and rhythm.
























